Program Goal

The goal of the program is to give support to those individuals who are completing the transitional phase from pediatrics to adult care. It will consists of 1-on-1 phone calls and/or text messages that will focus on healthy living with sickle cell disease. The program will use the web-based Mentor1to1[™] platform and PeerMentor[™] smartphone app.



Mentee Eligibility

The Peer-to-Peer Mentoring Program is currently available to anyone needing support and education in successfully transitioning into adult sickle cell health services.

- 1. Must be 18 years or older
- 2.. Have a valid government issued ID
- 3. Complete application requirements
- 4. Must be diagnosed with sickle cell disease
- 5. Must be transitioning to adult care
- 6. Must have a daily/regular phone (residence or a cellular line) that can be used to make mentoring phone calls.
- 7. Must have daily/regular access to a computer, tablet, or laptop with internet access
